- In pursuance of the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in CA No.4755/2001, contingent workers of Cachar Project, Silchar, who are a party in CA No.4755/2001 and who fulfill the criteria for selection to the above mentioned posts are advised to apply.

Other conditions: (1) The work is demanding and requires very high level of physical fitness. The deployment may be on round the clock shift /on-off duty pattern of work. (2) Selected candidates may be assigned to work in any onshore or offshore locations in India. (3) After initial screening, the candidates will be required to undergo written test, physical fitness test (wherever applicable), preliminary Medical examination for ruling out eye disorders like colour blindness, squint etc., Trade test wherever applicable and interview in any sequence as decided by ONGC. (4) Any candidate who is colour blind / has squint / or suffers from night blindness need not apply. (5) Candidates belonging to SC / ST category should be in possession of proper certificates in the prescribed format. The OBC caste certificate (with non-creamy layer) should be valid and in the format prescribed for appointment to posts under the Government of India. Only caste certificates issued by the Competent authority i.e. District Magistrate / Additional District Magistrate / Collector / Dy. Commissioner / Additional Dy. Commissioner / Dy. Collector / First Class Stipendiary Magistrate / Sub Divisional Magistrate / Taluka Magistrate / Executive Magistrate / Extra Assistant Commissioner (not below the rank of I class stipendiary Magistrate / Chief Presidency Magistrate / Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate / Presidency Magistrate / Chief Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahsildar / Sub Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and / or his family normally resides or any other authority as decided by Govt. of India, are acceptable. (6) Candidates with higher qualifications than indicated against each post need not apply. (7) The qualification should be from recognized University as per GOI guidelines / NCTVT/ State Board of Technical Education etc. (8) Candidature of candidates submitting false certificates or suppression / submission of incorrect information shall be liable for disqualification / rejection at any stage. (11) Applications sent by Registered post/ Speed post/ Courier/ or directly to ONGC **will not be entertained/ considered**. RECRUITMENT FOR FIELD OPERATOR ON TENURE BASIS

ONGC Nazira requires 52 (Fifty two) Field Operators (likely to increase) for Assam Asset on four year (04 years) tenure basis, to meet the requirements of the work plan for Hydrocarbon Blocks awarded to ONGC through NELP bidding. The job demands outdoor field work in shifts requiring considerable physical efforts and technical skills, and frequent relocation as demanded by the semi-mobile nature of operations to any Onshore/Offshore locations within the country. Candidates who meet the following criteria and are willing to be engaged on a **fixed tenure of four (04) years** may apply.

A. Qualifying Criteria:

(1) **Age limit:** 30 years for General candidates, 33 years for OBC candidates as on 31.05.2010. Relaxable for ex-apprentices of ONGC to the extent of their apprenticeship training in ONGC. (2) Educational/Professional Qualifications (a) High School (Class X) with ITI in any of- Fitting/Diesel/Turner/Machining/Welding trades. Minimum qualifying marks shall be 65% in ITI for General/OBC candidates. (b) Candidates with Diploma in Engineering in Mechanical or Production disciplines with atleast 60% marks for General/OBC candidates may also be considered.

Candidates with higher qualifications than those indicated above need not apply.

B. Physical standard & Fitness requirements:

a) Physical standard:

- Height 162 cms minimum, Weight 50 kgs minimum
- Chest 79 cms at expiration 84 cm after inspiration
- Vision- 6 x 6 without glasses & without any history of night/colour blindness/squint etc.

b) Physical Fitness:

- With one arm transport 20 kg object to 100 feet distance or 30 steps upstairs.
- With two arms transport 40 kg over 25 feet distance
- Climbing a vertical ladder of 100 feet
- Swing 5 kg sledge hammer-15 times (5 times overhand, 5 times underhand, 5 times side arm motions).

C. Remuneration : A consolidated salary of Rs.16,500/- inclusive of all allowances. An annual increment of 4 % is admissible on the tenure pay (Tenure Pay for the purpose of increment will be deemed to be Rs.5000/-), subject to satisfactory performance. Additionally PF and Bonus shall also be paid as per statutory rules.

D. Other Conditions: (a) These requirements arise in order to meet the time bound work program for hydrocarbon blocks, awarded under NELP bidding. As the work program is time bound and may change depending upon assessments after initial work, these requirements and engagements are limited to a fixed tenure of four (04) years only. (b) The work is demanding and requires very high level of physical fitness. The deployment may be on round the clock shift pattern of work. The standards prescribed for the test of Physical Fitness is illustrative of the nature of the work (c) Selected candidates may be assigned to work in any onshore or offshore location in India, during the tenure. (d) Selected candidates shall be required to sign an undertaking to the effect acknowledging that their engagement on tenure basis will not entitle them for any regular employment and that they will not move any court or authority, seeking regularization based on tenure engagement. (e) Reservation is applicable as per Government of India directives.

E. Selection Procedure : (a) After initial screening, the candidates will be required to undergo written test, physical fitness, preliminary Medical tests for ruling out eye disorders like colour blindness, squint etc., and interview, in any sequence as decided by ONGC. (b) Candidates meeting the above qualifying criteria and **registered with any of the employment exchange of State of Assam** may only apply, by submitting an application typed on A-4 size paper, as per the following format, affixing a passport size photograph on upper right hand corner of the application.

The envelope should be superscribed as **‘APPLICATION FOR THE POST OF FIELD OPERATOR and sent to Post Box No.91, GPO, Guwahati** on or before **09.07.2010**. Incomplete applications shall be summarily rejected.
