**A. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA :-**

**i) Age limit:**

30 years for General candidates, 33 years for OBC & 35 years for SC candidates as on 15.10. 2008.

**ii) Educational/Professional Qualifications:**

A Post Graduate Degree in Geophysics / Physics. One of the subjects in B.Sc should be Chemistry.

**B. Remuneration:**

Open ended Pay Rs.5100/- p.m. plus admissible allowances.

**C. Selection Procedure:**

- i) After initial screening, the candidates will be required to undergo written test, interview and such other tests as may be prescribed.
